



Fees & Whānau Payments

January 2011

- This Kindergarten provides the "20 Hours ECE" scheme for all three, four and five year old children.
- All families/whānau are asked to make a Whānau Payment of \$0.50 per hour for all their child's hours under the "20 Hours ECE" scheme.
- The Whānau Payment reduces to \$0.25 per hour for any second, third etc children from the same family attending at the same time.
- This Kindergarten charges a standard fee of \$3.50 including GST for any hours not covered by the "20 Hours ECE" scheme.
- The fee reduces to \$2.50 per hour for any second, third etc children from the same family attending at the same time.
- Two year olds will not be charged a fee if their families confirm they will use their "20 Hours ECE" hours at the Kindergarten after their third birthday. They will be asked for the Whānau Payment that would apply once they are using their "20 Hours ECE"
